Guidance:

On the first day, begin with a few minutes where you read the Construct. Continue on to the first question in the lab, and write your thoughts in a notebook or journal. Address the additional questions in the lab at a pace that works for you. Reflect on any insight gained or growth in progress as you close out the Construct.

The First Expectation

1 John 2:2 tells us “He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world.”

When you think about the expectations of God, you may view it with some flexibility. This could be because our God will not impose His will upon us. The Lord gives us free will. Scripture says “life and death are set before you ... choose life” (Deuteronomy 30:15-19). In other words, God lets us know that He made a way for our salvation. His Son, Jesus Christ, came to earth to atone the sins of the world, so that we may have life eternally and abundantly.

Let this settle into your heart, and rest in your soul. God has many expectations of His children, but He will never expect of you, what He has not already provided for you.

Accept the salvation that is offered to us by grace, through faith in Jesus Christ.

Prayer

Lord God, as I grow into an understanding that I am loved by You, help me to open my heart to the covering of Jesus Christ. May I be quick to harken to Your call, and not waiver, knowing that You will help me to build a relationship with You. Teach me who I am in Christ. In Jesus Name I pray. Amen.

Practical Application / Lab

Read the scripture below:

John 3:17 “For God sent not His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved”

Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to help you to grasp this truth reflected in John 3:17.

This is a sacred moment that will illuminate the love of Christ in your heart, because it allows you to see the grace of God to atone our sins. Scripture tells us that the lamb was slain from the foundations of the earth: this means that Jesus was always going to cover us, and pay the price for our sins, so that we can have redemption through Him.

During this Construct, write out what John 3:17 means to you personally. Allow the Holy Spirit to provide revelation knowledge by being open to insight and wisdom into the purpose of the crucifixion. Pray through this, and if led, ask Jesus to come into your heart as your personal Lord and Savior.
