Guidance:

On the first day, begin with a few minutes where you read the Construct. Continue on to the first question in the lab, and write your thoughts in a notebook or journal. Address the additional questions in the lab at a pace that works for you. Reflect on any insight gained or growth in progress as you close out the Construct.

Listening Diligently

Deuteronomy 28:1 tells us “... if you faithfully obey the voice of the Lord your God, being careful to do all His commandments that I command you today, the Lord your God will set you high above all the nations of the earth.”

Once you listen diligently to the voice of God, you automatically position yourself for blessings to overtake you. God knows how to make you aware that it is His Spirit prompting, guiding, and revealing knowledge to you. However, it is easier to discern God when you become familiar with His ways and character. To do this requires learning His word that reflects biblical principles and truths about His kingdom. The key is to not just listen, but to take heed. This shows diligence - to put action behind what you know is God.

Usually when the Lord instructs you, it will be a faith walk. It does not make sense to the natural eye – and sometimes will be uncomfortable to human nature.

However, this is one of the ways that you serve the purposes of God. How do you know it is God? As you spend time with Him - in His word, prayer, and worship - the Holy Spirit will minister to you so that you know in your spirit that it is the Lord. Then in whichever direction He leads you, it will take faith, and though it may feel unnatural, you will have a *peace that surpasses all understanding*.

Prayer

Dear Father, thank You for biblical principles and knowledge that reveals truths about Your kingdom. As I put forth effort to learn Your word, I pray to grow in wisdom and understanding. Teach me how to discern Your Spirit so that I may listen diligently to Your word. May I put faith behind what I believe, walking out the word that I hear. In Jesus Name I pray. Amen.

Practical Application / Lab

Obedience to God postures our hearts and positions us to walk in the grace that God gives, so that He gets the glory.

Take time to think about obedience to God, and the truth that it was disobedience by Adam and Eve that led to sin entering the world, separating man from God.

Jesus paid the price for our sins, and made a way for us to live in covenant relationship with God. He justified us, and made us the righteousness of God in Christ. In covenant with God, we are partners with Him, therefore our obedience reflects our reverence and commitment to Him. Obedience also opens the door to supernatural blessings.

Read Deuteronomy 28 and ask the Holy Spirit to help you to grasp these verses in your soul. Listen diligently (notice) to any revelation knowledge or wisdom imparted unto you.
